## Guiding principle for tube feeding

## **Steps of feeding**

- 1. Sitting up at a 45-degree angle and keep in an upright position for 1 hour after the feeding is finished.
- 2. Clean your hands.
- 3. Gather your supplies in a clean and comfortable place.
- 4. Open the plug at end of feeding tube.
- 5. Flush feeding tube with 30-60ml of sterile water.
- 6. Wipe the top of the formula can with a clean cloth or papter towel. Pour the prescribed amount of formula into the empty container. Draw up the formula into the syringe.
- 7. Put the catheter tip syringe into the feeding tube or button adapter. Make sure that the tip of the syringe is placed firmly.
- 8. Unclamp the feeding tube and slowly push the plunger down. Clamp the feeding tube in between each syringe of formula to prevent leakage.
- 9. Refill the syringe with formula. Repeat the procedure until you have injected the prescribed amount of formula. Clamp the feeding tube.
- 10. Hold the syringe upright and fill it with 30-60 ml of sterile water.
- 11. After each feeding, pull the syringe apart and rinse all of the equipment with warm water. Let the supplies air dry.

## **Important points**

- 1. Always reclamp the feeding tube before removing the catheter tip syringe to avoid leakage.
- 2. Move the clamp on the feeding tube to avoid permanent kinking of the tube.
- 3. To avoid clogging, always flush the feeding tube with the amount of water recommended by NP or dietitian (usually 30-60 ml) before and after
  - Each feeding.
  - Taking each medication.
  - Taking additional clear liquids.

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
