Medication Use Instruction Sheet

Onbrez®Breezhaler

■ Medication Name

Indacaterol 150 mcg

■ Indication and Mechanism

Used for Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD). Can relieve wheezing, coughing, and shortness of breath by opening up the airways.

Directions









- 1. Remove cap (Picture 1).
- 2. Remove mouthpiece.
- 3. Remove capsule from blister and place in chamber (Picture 2).
- 4. Close mouthpiece until it clicks (picture 3).
- 5. Press side piercing buttons in once and release to pierce the capsule, do not shake (Picture 4).
- 6. Exhale gently and away from the inhaler
- 7. Close lips around mouthpiece to form good seal.
- 8. Breathe in slowly and steadily. The capsule will vibrate as you breathe.
- 9. Breathe in as long as possible.
- 10. Hold breath for about 5 seconds, or as long as possible. Remove inhaler from mouth.

- 11. Breathe out gently and away from inhaler (Picture 5).
- 12. Open mouthpiece and remove used capsule (Picture 6).
- 13. If there is still drug in the capsule, repeat all steps starting from step 3.
- 14. Clean the chamber of the breezhalor.
- 15. Close mouthpiece and cap.

■ Be careful of...

- Not piercing the capsule
- Piercing the capsule more than once
- Not using a new capsule for each dose
- Not breathing in forcefully enough

■ What if I miss a dose?

■ Immediately take a dose within the same day. Do not use more than once a day.

■ Cleaning Instructions

Clean the inhaler once a week. Wipe the mouthpiece with a clean alcohol pad or tissue.
