

Medication Use Instruction Sheet

Instruction For Use of Topical Patch and Precautions

■ Brand name and content

Flurbi PAP : Flurbiprofen

■ Medication appearance

Blue and white package with white patch

■ Mechanism of action

Provides pain relief for patients by absorbing the medication through the skin.

■ Medication appearance

- 1. Apply to large surfaces of healthy skin to prevent the patch from falling off. Avoid applying on wounds or areas of radiation.
- 2. Rinse skin with water before application. Pat dry to ensure the skin is dry before applying the patch.
- 3. Peel plastic off the patch. Apply to skin and press firmly on the patch for 10 seconds to ensure complete contact between the patch and skin. Tape or gauze may also be used to ensure the patch stays onto the skin. It may be obtained from the counseling area.
- 4. When removing the patch, fold the patch inward (with the medication inside) and dispose in the garbage. Do not flush in toilet.
- 5. Apply to a different area of the body each time to avoid adverse reactions. Each site of application should be rotated every few days.

■ Precautions

- 1. Each patch is effective for 6 to 8 hours. If the patch is left on the skin for over 8 hours, allergies and rashes may occur.
- 2. Patches may contain irritants (camphor, menthol, etc). Avoid showering when the patch is on.

■ What if I miss a dose?

- The potency of this medication lasts 6 to 8 hours, you may stop the medication while pain relieved.
- DO NOT double up the doses if you missed a dose.

■ Possible side effects

- Side effects include slight itching.
- If condition continues to progress, become serious or the itchy sensation is not relieved, seek treatment immediately.
- These patches contain NSAIDs. If there are any renal or hepatic deficiencies, or sensitivities, please contact your physician or pharmacist.

■ Storage

- Refrigeration is not necessary unless instructed.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Please discard when the medicine is expired.
- Do not share medication with others.
