A ureteral stone is a renal stone that has moved down into the ureter. If it has grown larger by the time & may become lodged in a narrow part of the ureter, causing pain & possibly blocking the flow of urine. The CT shows a large radio-opaque upper ureteral stone (arrow) with marked hydronephrosis & contrast stasis in dilated pelvocalyceal system of left kidney.
