Imaging findings

- Grouped amorphous microcalcifications at 3 o'clock direction of left breast (BIRADS 4)
- OP scar: 3cm at right 6.5/4
 - → Partial mastectomy
 Invasive ductal carcinoma (IDC)
- OP scar: 2cm right 12.5/3.5
 - ExcisionSclerosing adenosis

Sclerosing adenosis

- Benign proliferative condition of the terminal duct lobular units characterized by an increased number of acini and their glands
- Usually detected on mammography and has a wide range of mammographic presentations thus difficult to distinguish from breast cancer by imaging, and can be mistaken for tubular carcinoma at pathology
- Calcifications most common, 47% on mammography: Amorphous ± round, punctate > pleomorphic
- Not considered a pre-malignant lesion, but is associated with a 1.7-2.5x increased risk of developing breast cancer
