Imaging findings

- ✓ Increased density of the entire right breast
 - → Core needle biopsy
 Malignant lymphoma
 (diffuse large B cell lymphoma)

Lymphoma

- Breast lymphoma accounts for <1% of all breast malignancies and <2% of all extranodal non-Hodgkin lymphoma.
- Secondary lymphoma is the most common type of secondary malignancy/metastasis involving the breast (17%)
- B-cell lymphoma >>> T-cell, age 50-60
 - Most common subtype subtype = diffuse large B-cell
 - A minority of cases are follicular lymphoma, MALT lymphoma, or Burkitt lymphoma
- Rapidly enlarging, painless, palpable mass
 - UOQ most common, Right > left (60:40 ratio)
 - Bilateral synchronous 10%
