



Ans: Multiple myeloma

Clinical:

Average age: 50-70,

Male >> Female

Bence-Jones protein in 40-60%
of patients

X-ray findings:

Widespread lucencies in bone

Discrete, “punched-out” lesions
(arrows)

Uniform in size, Usually multiple
in
vertebrae, ribs, skull, pelvis &
femur

Differential diagnosis:

Metastases.

Disuse osteoporosis
