

Ovarian teratoma

The most common ovarian neoplasm in patients younger than 20 years. KUB may show calcific and **tooth** components with the pelvis.

Typically CT images demonstrate **fat** (areas with very low Hounsfield values), fat fluid level, calcification (sometimes tooth), Rokitansky protuberance and tufts of hair.

Whenever the size exceeds 10cms or soft tissue plugs and cauliflower appearance with irregular borders is seen, malignant transformation should be suspected.
