

Ans: Scaphoid fracture



Scaphoid fracture is the most common type of carpal bone fracture that is often diagnosed by X-rays. The complication of a scaphoid fracture is avascular necrosis that depends on the location of the fracture (proximal 1/3 have a high incidence of AVN). Non-union can also occur from undiagnosed or undertreated scaphoid fractures. The scaphoid view provides an elongated image of the scaphoid that can reveal a fracture (arrow) that is not evident in any of the other views.
